The Future is Happening Now: Metropolitan Transportation Plan Update



The Farmington Metropolitan Planning Organization held 3 public meetings this quarter to receive input, comments and ideas for the updating of the Metropolitan Transportation Plan. These meetings took place at the following locations:

Maps were available to the attendees to make notes, share where they believe roads should be and to add any comments regarding the maps. In addition, current Red Apple Transit routes were plotted on maps and participants were asked to indicate where they would like to see new future routes and bus stops.

New Mexico Air Quality Department

The NM Air Quality Department presented a report at the MPO Technical Committee Meeting on February 26, 2009. On March 12, 2008 EPA reduced ozone standards from .080 to .075ppm. Readings from the monitoring station near Navajo Lake indicate an ozone level of .075ppm, which keeps the County in attainment. If any local stations do not meet the .075ppm standard, it will cause all future transportation projects to be evaluated for conformity to this standard.



Phase 1 Funding for completing a SRTS Action Plan and for Educational & Encouragement activities was awarded to the City of Farmington in February!

The SRTS Champion, Lori Meszaros, has been very busy this Winter organizing SRTS activities for the Spring. As the weather warms up, the SRTS group will be conducting walking assessments of local schools. These assessments will be completed by groups of students that will walk the one mile corridor around the schools to identify any conditions that hinder walking or bike riding students. Also during April, Student Arrival Counts will be taken at participating schools, which includes counting those who walk, bike, or are dropped-off by parents or school buses. These counts will be taken at McKinley and Apache Elementary Schools.
