

**FARMINGTON MPO**  
**FY2009 Annual List of Federally Obligated Projects**

As described by the transportation bill, the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, and Efficient Transportation Equity Act – A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU), the Farmington Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is required to develop an Annual List of Federally Obligated Projects. This list includes all federally funded transportation projects obligated in FY2009 (October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2009) for Aztec, Bloomfield, Farmington, and the urbanized area of San Juan County. Transportation projects include roadway and transit. These projects are also part of the MPO Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

The following table includes the Farmington MPO FY2009 Annual List of Obligated Projects. The table includes project descriptions and federal funding sources and amounts.
